

**CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**MINUTES OF**  
**FEBRUARY 26, 2019**

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on February 26, 2019 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:01 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman, and member Barry Good, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, Code Official Jeff Fiant and Secretary Cheryl Haus.

**A motion was made by Barry Good to approve the minutes from January 22, 2019. Seconded by Charles Zimmerman. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

**ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS / SOLICITORS REPORT – ELIZABETH MAGOVERN -**

**ROAD DEPARTMENT**

The Road Department has been patching roads, brush cutting, repairing signs and removing snow /ice.

**A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to award the 2019 Road Project of tarring and chipping various roads to AMS in the amount of \$401,286.56. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

**A motion as made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the quiderail quote of \$2,561.00 for Schuylkill Hill Road to J/M Fence. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

**A motion as made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to approve the quiderail quote of \$2,631.00 for Belleman’s Church Road / Irish Creek Road to J/M Fence. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

**A motion as made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the quiderail quote of \$2,433.00 for Railroad Road to J/M Fence. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

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**ENGINEER'S REPORT – RYAN RHODE**

Engineer Ryan Rhode stated The Planning Commission meeting for February 20, 2019 was cancelled. On the agenda for March will be the Spatz subdivision @ 850 Plum Road. A letter of direction from the Attorney's office will be sent to Mr. & Mrs. Harold Spatz for their subdivision on Irish Creek Road.

Mr. Rhode will finalize paperwork for bids for the completion of stormwater requirements at the Maple Leaf Subdivision. These bids will go out in spring.

**A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to accept the property of David and Linda Nirschl of 1888 Rake Road into the Agricultural Security Area. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Good and Troutman voted yes.**

The Liquid Fuels audit from January 1-31, 2017 was received. Centre Township was copied on a Notice of Violation by Upper Bern Township to 254 Jungle Road.

**A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to designate April, 2019 as “Pennsylvania 811 Safe Digging Month”. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.**

**The meeting was recessed at 7:20 p.m. for an executive session;  
The meeting was reconvened at 7:40 p.m. regarding potential litigation.**
