MINUTES OF APRIL 28, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on April 28, 2020 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:03 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman, Member James Fitterling, Attorney Liz Magovern, and Secretary Cheryl Haus. Due to the Governor mandates due to the coronavirus, no public was in attendance. The meeting agenda was posted on the Township's website and doors so the public could review it. A motion for Resolution 2020-10 was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to extend the flat rate of the 2020 county & township real estate taxes until September 30, 2020, to mirror Berks County, with no late penalty fee. Upon roll call, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.
