

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
DECEMBER 17, 2019

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on December 17, 2019 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Member Barry Good and Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, and Secretary Cheryl Haus.

HEARING OF VISITORS ON AGENDA ITEMS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Barry Good to approve the minutes from November 26, 2019. Seconded by Charles Zimmerman. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Troutman and Good voted yes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve payment of the bills. Seconded by Barry Good. Upon roll call, Good, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS / SOLICITORS REPORT - ELIZABETH MAGOVERN - NONE

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The Road Department did cutting of trees, cleaning culverts and cindering.

ENGINEER'S REPORT - RYAN RHODE

After review, Gin Mill Culvert does not need a DEP permit. Paperwork will be done for bidding in spring 2020.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion for Resolution # 18, 2019 was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to approve the Centre Township final 2020 budget. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Good and Troutman voted yes.

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A motion for Resolution # 19, 2019 was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to set the 2020 real estate tax rate at .36 mills, keeping taxes the same. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.

A motion for Resolution # 20, 2019 was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to set the 2020 Street light tax at \$.35 per front foot, keeping taxes the same. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Good and Troutman voted yes.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the payment of bills as of December 31, 2019 and reaffirm at the January meeting. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to transfer \$43,000.00 from account # 473.10, Land Preservation to 436.00, Stormwater, as a result of the Maple Leaf Stormwater Project. Upon roll call, Good, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to transfer \$10,000.00 from account # 400.35, Insurance & Bonding to 432.200, Snow & Ice as a result of shortage for salt and anti-skid. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Good and Troutman voted yes.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Jason Troutman to transfer \$25,000.00 from account # 430.35, Insurance & Bonding to 437.200, Repairs of Tools and Machinery, as a result of \$18,000.00 needed to fix the MACK dump truck. Upon roll call, Good, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to transfer \$10,000.00 from account # 400.35, Insurance & Bonding to 484.00, Workers Compensation due to Centerport Borough's Workers Compensation of \$10,988.00. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Good and Troutman voted yes.

HEARING OF VISITORS

Mr. Breidegam questioned the meeting on December 27, 2019 regarding the Nuisance Ordinance for removal of trash and rubbish.

Chairman Jason Troutman recognized Supervisor Barry Good and attendance at his last meeting, and thanked him for his services as Supervisor to Centre Township.
