

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
FEBRUARY 25, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on February 25, 2020 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 6:58 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, Codes Official Jeff Fiant and Secretary Cheryl Haus.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to appoint James Fitterling as Township Supervisor. Upon roll call, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.

Mr. Fitterling took the seat as Township Supervisor.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to appoint Mike Haag to the Center Township Planning Commission. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

HEARING OF VISITORS ON AGENDA ITEMS

Tom Dietrich of 908 Sleepy Hollow Road presented a letter to the Supervisors regarding the location of his septic system to be pumped. The location of the system requires the pumper to drive on the property when the ground is frozen. The ground did not freeze during the winter of 2019-2020. The Supervisors agreed to move the pumping to next year. A copy of the letter will be sent to Jeremy Bentz, the Township SEO.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve the minutes from January 28, 2020. Seconded by James Fitterling. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Troutman and Fitterling voted yes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve payment of the bills. Seconded by James Fitterling. Upon roll call, Fitterling, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS / SOLICITORS REPORT - ELIZABETH MAGOVERN -

The uniform contract with Unifirst has been cancelled. The Attorney will write a letter to Unifirst confirming cancellation.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to authorize Attorney Magovern to prepare and advertise the ordinances for wording amendments to the township pension plans. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

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A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by James Fitterling for Resolution # 2020-8 to follow the schedules and procedures for disposition of records as set forth in the records manual. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Fitterling and Troutman voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to authorize Attorney Magovern to prepare separate Agreements for Road Sharing Intergovernmental Cooperation with Tilden and Penn Townships. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The Road Department patched roads, placed / repaired signs, and trimmed trees.

ENGINEER'S REPORT – RYAN RHODE

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve 2 partial waivers and 6 waivers, as referenced on the David Good Poultry Plan, and the letter of Kraft Engineering dated February 12, 2020. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to give Preliminary approval on the David Good Poultry Plan, subject to the Kraft Engineering letter of February 12, 2020. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to conditionally approve the Final David Good Poultry Plan, subject to the review letter of Kraft Engineering, dated February 12, 2020. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to advertise the MS4 Pollutant Reduction Plan (PRP), dealing with the sediment issue, for a 30 day public review to submit public concerns and answers to those concerns. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes

ZONING OFFICER REPORT – Jeff Fiant

Jeff Fiant, Codes Official stated 4 permits were issued, 12 inspections were completed and 2 property maintenance issues were acted upon.

SEO REPORT –

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to accept the SEO report. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Fitterling and Troutman voted yes.

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NEW BUSINESS

The meeting was recessed at 7:20 p.m. for an Executive Session regarding potential litigation.

The meeting was reconvened at 8:00 p.m.

MISCELLANEOUS

The Supervisors received a copy of a letter from Systems Design Engineering regarding the progress of the Fairview Mobile Home Park hookup to the Sanitary Sewer System.
