

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
JANUARY 28, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 28, 2020 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. Engineer Ryan Rhode reported that he has reviewed the plan for Nolt Poultry, spoke with the RoadMaster on 2 culverts for replacement and various roads for the 2020 road project of sealing.
