

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
JULY 28, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on July 28, 2020 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:10 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman and Member James Fitterling, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, Code Official Jeff Fiant and Secretary Cheryl Haus. Due to the Governor mandates due to the coronavirus, no public was in attendance. The meeting agenda was posted on the Township's doors and website so the public could review it. The Township received no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by James Fitterling to approve the minutes from June 23, 2020. Seconded by Charles Zimmerman. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Troutman and Fitterling voted yes.

ENGINEER'S REPORT - RYAN RHODE -

A discussion was held regarding the Noecker Poultry Land Development Plan. The NPDES permit has been issued, The last review by Kraft Engineering was July 27, 2020 The plan is zoning compliant.

The plan will be reviewed at the Planning Commission meeting on August 19, 2020 and reviewed by the Supervisors at their meeting on August 25, 2020.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to authorize Kraft Engineering to complete the Drainage Improvements Project plans and advertise for bids for the August meeting, for culvert replacement on Pony / Gin Mill Roads. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

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Discussion was held on a driveway at 1120 Plum Road. Before the meeting the Zoning Officer discussed this problem with the neighboring tenant who stated he will help the owner address the problem on Sunday.

Discussion was held on a complaint at 77 Easter Street regarding water from a field, running onto a private alley and crossing Easter Street and damaging a shed at 77 Easter Street. Supervisor Jason Troutman will visit the property and discuss with the Roadmaster if anything can be done.

Codes Official Jeff Fiant discussed a complaint regarding excessive explosives and excessive gun fire.
