

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
SEPTEMBER 24, 2019

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on September 24, 2019 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Member Barry Good called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Barry Good and Vice Chairman Charles Zimmerman, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, Code Official Jeff Fiant and Secretary Cheryl Haus. Supervisor Jason Troutman was absent.

HEARING OF VISITORS ON AGENDA ITEMS – NONE

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve the minutes from August 27, 2019. Seconded by Barry Good. Upon roll call, Zimmerman and Good voted yes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve payment of the bills. Seconded by Barry Good. Upon roll call, Good and Zimmerman voted yes.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS / SOLICITORS REPORT – ELIZABETH MAGOVERN -

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The Road Department continues to maintain the roads, doing a very good job.

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to ratify the hiring of Andrew Werley as a road crew employee, as of September 23, 2019, with a starting wage of \$18.00 per hour. Upon roll call, Zimmerman and Good voted yes.

ENGINEER'S REPORT – RYAN RHODE

The culvert project (Maple Leaf Acres) has been completed and both Township Engineer Ryan Rhode and Road Foreman Ryan Mock stated that they were pleased with the work. There will be a 12-month maintenance agreement should there be a problem with the asphalt.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$5,949.22 and payment application # 1 in the amount of \$42,269.12 to J. Phillips Excavating for the Maple Leaf Acres / Irish Creek Road Stormwater Project. Upon roll call, Zimmerman and Good voted yes.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT – Jeff Fiant

8 permits were issued for last month and a number of property maintenance issues were closed out.

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SEO REPORT –

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by Barry Good to accept the SEO report from JB Environmental. Upon roll call, Zimmerman and Good voted yes.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the 2020 MMO for the Non-Uniformed Pension Plan in the amount of \$5,554.00. Upon roll call, Good and Zimmerman voted yes.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the 2020 MMO for the Police Pension Plan in the amount of \$.00 (fully funded). Upon roll call, Good and Zimmerman voted yes.

A motion was made by Barry Good and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve the request of a 90 day time extension for the King's Academy Land Development plan. Upon roll call, Good and Zimmerman voted yes.

MISCELLANEOUS

HEARING OF VISITORS

Solomon Lash and Patrick Manwiller of the Schuylkill Valley Community Library thanked the Supervisors for their continued support. Mr. Manwiller talked about the good the library has brought to his family.

Tim Lehner asked the Supervisors if anyone has looked at the bridge at Irish Creek Road and Belleman's Church Road. The sides are crumbling. The Roadmaster will be asked to look at it.

Theresa LaBruno asked again about the grass at 123 Mickey Court. Code Official Jeff Fiant replied that it is a process and a NOV has been sent.
