

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
MARCH 23, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 23, 2021 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:03 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Chairman Jason Troutman, Vice Chairman James Fitterling, and Member Charles Zimmerman, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode, Zoning Officer Jeff Fiant and Secretary Cheryl Haus. The agenda was on the website and posted on the township doors for questions / comments. No comments or questions were received.

HEARING OF VISITORS ON AGENDA ITEMS - none

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by James Fitterling to approve the minutes from February 23, 2021. Seconded by Charles Zimmerman. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Troutman and Fitterling voted yes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman to approve payment of the bills. Seconded by James Fitterling. Upon roll call, Fitterling, Troutman and Zimmerman voted yes.

ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS / SOLICITORS REPORT - ELIZABETH MAGOVERN -

Litigation items were discussed.

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The Road Department trimmed trees, salted roads, truck repairs, worked on concrete pipe on Blattadahl Road.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to advertise for bids to be received by April 22 and awarded April 27, 2021, for the 2021 Road Project to oil & chip Manor Drive, Shannaleigh Drive, Mickey Court, Cornerstone Drive. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

ENGINEER'S REPORT - RYAN RHODE

The Engineer has presented a listing of residents surrounding the Shannaleigh and Quarry Drive stormwater facilities. Letters will be sent to all residents informing them that ATV's on the road and in the stormwater facilities will not be tolerated.

A discussion was held on the status of the Trolley Court roadway and the township taking over the road. An escrow account for the costs has not been found. The Engineer and Zoning Officer will talk to Omega Builders for information.

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A resident presented a concern that the swale was not installed on the Noecker Poultry land development.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT – Jeff Fiant

8 inspections were completed, 3 C & O's were issued.

SEO REPORT –

A motion was made by Charles Zimmerman and seconded by James Fitterling to approve the SEO report for March. Upon roll call, Zimmerman, Fitterling and Troutman voted yes.

The SEO will be instructed to move to inspecting the Fairview Mobile Home Park every other week.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to ratify the approval at the February meeting, of Resolution # 11, 2021, to renew the mowing contract with PennDOT for maintenance services, for three years. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

MISCELLANEOUS

There was discussion of a spring and fall Centre Township newsletter. Meetings being held through COVID-19, ordinances relating to spring / summer activities (burning, grass, trash, etc), information for new residents of the township, permits, etc.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to approve a 90 day extension for the Long Annexation plan. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.
