

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF

VACATING TOWNSHIP ROAD NO. 689

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Super-
visors of Center Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby
enacted and ordained under the authority of the Act of the General Assembly
of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, approved May 1, 1933, P. L. 103,
as amended, known as "The Second Class Township Code", as follows:

Township Road No. 689 is hereby vacated
for its entire length of 1.3 miles from its
termini at State Highway Route Nos. 06193
and 06164, as shown on the Map attached
hereto and made a part hereof.

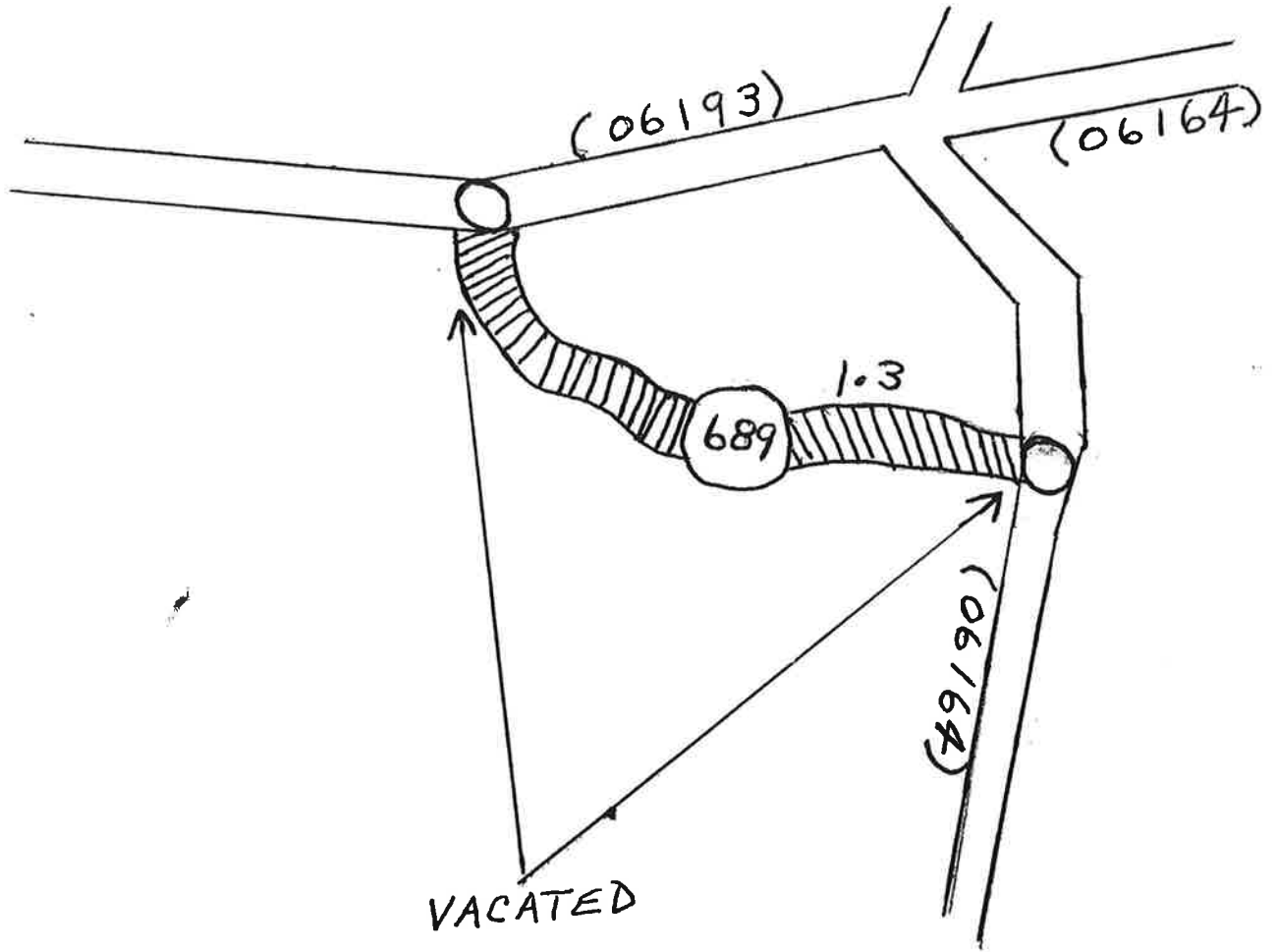
