

ORDINANCE NO. 18-1977

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING THAT SEWAGE PERMITS SHALL BE REQUIRED FOR RURAL RESIDENCES REGARDLESS OF SIZE; AND REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Centre, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. Sewage permits shall be required for rural residences within the Township regardless of lot size in the same manner as they are required for other residences under the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, as amended, 35 P. S. Sec. 750.1 et seq., except as hereinafter provided.

SECTION 2. Sewage requirements for rural residences upon lots in excess of ten (10) acres in size shall be issued only following design and inspection by the Township Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer and, at the option of the owner of said rural residence, one of the following alternatives:

- a. Either a full percolation test shall be conducted with the results thereof read by the Township Certified Sewage Enforcement Officer; or
- b. The largest specified conventional system as designated by Chapter 73 of the Rules and Regulations to the aforesaid Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, shall be installed.

SECTION 3. All fees for the issuance of said permit shall be as required under the fee schedule set forth in a current Township Resolution.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar as the same are inconsistent herewith.
