ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND GRANTING THE PLANNING COMMISSION POWERS AND DUTIES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the Township of Centre in the County of Berks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of the same:

ARTICLE I. There is hereby created a Planning Commission to be composed of four members to be named by the Supervisors of Centre Township and to be known as the Centre Township Planning Commission. This Commission shall recommend to the Supervisors the boundaries of various original districts and appropriate regulations to be enforced therein.

ARTICLE II. The Commission shall have the duties and obligations as set out in Act 247 of the 1968 Session of the Legislature of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and as it may be amended from time to time, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

ARTICLE III. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

ENACTED and ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 1st day of April, 1971.
