

ORDINANCE NO. 29-1985

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA WHICH PROVIDES THAT NO PERSON SHALL OBSTRUCT HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY BY VARIOUS MEANS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION AND PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Centre, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1 - In order to keep all township highway right of way, both the travelled portion as well as any other portions free and clear of all obstructions and debris of any type or kind, it is hereby ordained that no person shall pump, throw, shovel and/or allow to migrate or filter onto the Township right of way ice, snow, manure, soil, manure mixed with soil, nor shall any person, sow, plant, harvest, cultivate, disc harrow, or utilize in connection with ownership of adjacent property in any manner any portion of Township right of way.

SECTION 2 - Penalty for Violation:

Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be sentenced to pay a fine not exceeding Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

SECTION 4 - Repeal of Certain Prior Ordinances. All prior ordinances of the Township of Centre are repealed and declared

unenforceable in so far as they are inconsistent with or identical to any provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5 - Effective Date - This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after enactment.
