

ORDINANCE No. 49-1990

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 26-1985 OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING AND PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS: DEFINING CERTAIN TERMS, PROVIDING FOR THE MATTER OF ADOPTING PERMANENT TRAFFIC AND PARKING REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY AND EMERGENCY REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR EXPERIMENTAL REGULATIONS, ESTABLISHING THE AUTHORITY OF PEACE OFFICERS TO DIRECT TRAFFIC, PROVIDING TRAFFIC REGULATIONS GOVERNING MOTOR VEHICLES SUCH AS PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVEN ON SIDEWALKS, PROHIBITING U-TURNS, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS AT CERTAIN STREETS THROUGHOUT THE TOWNSHIP, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO OPERATE MOTOR VEHICLES OR TRACTORS ON HIGHWAYS CLOSED FOR CONSTRUCTION OR REPAIR, AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PLAY HIGHWAYS, PROVIDING FOR FILLING OUT OF ACCIDENT REPORTS, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN YIELD INTERSECTIONS, PROVIDING PARKING REGULATIONS, PROVIDING FOR VEHICLES TO BE PARKED WITHIN MARKED SPACED, PROHIBITING PARKING AT ALL TIMES AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS AS DEFINED IN THE ORDINANCE, PROHIBITING PARKING ON ALL BRIDGES, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE AFORESAID REGULATIONS, DECLARING AND ESTABLISHING CERTAIN SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY ROUTES, PROHIBITING PARKING ON SPECIFIC HIGHWAYS DURING EMERGENCY AND RESTRICTING OF OPERATIONS OR MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRACTORS ON SUCH HIGHWAYS, AUTHORIZING THE PLACING OF SIGNS ALONG HIGHWAYS EFFECTED FOR SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY ROUTES, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF SNOW AND ICE EMERGENCY ROUTE REQUIREMENTS, PROVIDING FOR THE REMOVAL OF ILLEGALLY-PARKED VEHICLES, APPROVING STORAGE GARAGE FOR SUCH VEHICLES, APPROVING BONDING REQUIREMENT FOR SUCH GARAGE, PROVIDING FOR TOWING AND STORAGE CHARGES AND PROCEDURES FOR NOTIFICATION OF REMOVAL AND IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PAYMENT OF TOWING AND IMPOUNDING CHARGES WITHOUT PROTEST, PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE PAYMENT OF CHARGES UNDER PROTEST, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OR RECORDS OF VEHICLES REMOVED AND IMPOUNDED, PROVIDING THAT THE OWNER OR OPERATOR OF VEHICLE REMOVED OR IMPOUNDED REMAIN LIABLE FOR FINE OR PENALTY, RESTRICTING REMOVAL OF IMPOUNDED VEHICLES, PROVIDING FOR THE SEVERABILITY OF THE ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OR PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES, PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE, PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORITY TO ERECT ALL SIGNS, PLAQUES AND HIGHWAY MATERIALS NEEDED TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS AND INTENT OF THE ORDINANCE. THE SAID AMENDMENT TO SECTION 12.1 PROVIDING FOR A MAXIMUM RATE OF SPEED ON CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TOWNSHIP ROADS IN ADDITION

TO TOWNSHIP ROADS MENTIONED IN ORDINANCE NO. 30-1985, AND ORDINANCE No. 46-1990.

Section 1. Section 12.1(a) and 12.1(b) of Ordinance No. 30-1985 is hereby amended governing maximum speed limits established on certain roads by adding additional speed limits governing certain roads.

(a) Maximum speed limits are established on portions of specified roads, or for the entire length of a road, as follows, and it shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle, on any part of a road where a maximum speed limit applies, at a higher speed than the maximum prescribed for that road or section or road:

	<u>Road</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Maximum Speed Limit</u>
1.	Trolley	Entire Length	35 Miles Per Hour
2.	Gin Mill Road	Entire Length	15 Miles Per Hour
3.	Grove Road	Entire Length	30 Miles Per Hour

(b) Any person who violates any provision of this section shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$35. Any person exceeding the maximum speed limit by more than five (5) miles per hour shall pay an additional fine of \$2 per mile for each mile in excess of five (5) miles per hour over the maximum speed limit.

Section 2. Repeal of Certain Prior Ordinances.

All prior ordinances of the Township of Centre in so far as they deal with maximum speeds on the roads or portions or roads referred to in Section 1 are repealed and declared unenforceable in so far as they are inconsistent with or identical to any provision of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect the earliest day allowed by law.
