ORDINANCE # 56-1991

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE AND THE BOROUGH OF CENTERPORT, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND GRANTING THE JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION POWERS AND DUTIES REPEALING PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES, AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS of the Township of Centre in the County of Berks and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of the same:

ARTICLE I. There is hereby created a Joint Planning
Commission to be composed of six members four to be named by the
Supervisors of Centre Township and two to be named by the Council
of the Borough of Centerport and to be known as the Joint Centre
Township and Centerport Borough Planning Commission. This
Commission shall recommend to the Supervisors and the Borough
action to be taken on any request for subdivision and land
development in the respective municipalities.

ARTICLE II. The Joint Planning Commission shall have the duties and obligations as set out in the Municipalities Planning Code, as amended and in particular the sections of the Code referring to Joint Planning Commissions, and as it may be amended from time to time, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

ARTICLE III. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption by the Township of Centre and the adoption by the Borough of Centerport of a companion Ordinance on the earliest date allowed by law.

ARTICLE IV. All prior ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are repealed including Ordinance No. 2 being an Ordinance Creating a Township Planning Commission of the Township of Centre.
