

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES OF
JANUARY 25, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 25, 2022 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road, Mohrsville, PA. Supervisor Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: Jason Troutman, James Fitterling and Charles Zimmerman, Attorney Liz Magovern, Engineer Ryan Rhode and Secretary Cheryl Haus. Zoning Officer Jeff Fiant were absent.

HEARING OF VISITORS ON AGENDA ITEMS –

Dennis Stamm of 138 Adam Street discussed with the Board the bus stop at in front of his home. Mr. Stamm was given the name and number of the Director of Transportation at the Schuylkill Valley School District.

Harry Peters of 34 Irish Run Road discussed time needed to clean up and organize his property. He said he has rain barrels, firewood, recycling cans which are not junk. The Zoning Officer was not at the meeting, however, the Engineer will discuss this with him.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made by James Fitterling to approve the minutes from December 21, 2021 and January 3, 2022. Seconded by Charles Zimmerman. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS

ROAD DEPARTMENT

The Road Department has been salting / plowing roads, tree trimming, servicing / repairing trucks.

A motion was made by James Fitterling and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to rent a street sweeper for approximately \$2,700.00 from April 25 through May 6, 2022. Upon roll call, Fitterling, Zimmerman and Troutman voted yes.

ENGINEER'S REPORT – RYAN RHODE

Engineer Ryan Rhode gave the monthly Engineering report.

Trolley Road will be measured for a 2022 project.

A meeting with property owners on Tower Road regarding a run-off problem will be done in the spring.

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ZONING OFFICER REPORT –

Engineer Ryan Rhode gave the December report.
6 property maintenance issues were dealt with. 15 building inspection were done.

SEO REPORT –

A report was not received from the SEO. Very little SEO work has been done this month.

NEW BUSINESS

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by Charles Zimmerman to re-affirm the Verizon Wireless Preliminary Final Land Development plan due to the 90 day expiration for recording. Upon roll call, Troutman, Zimmerman and Fitterling voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to defer land development reviews for the Kenneth Snyder Poultry Operation to Penn Township since all improvements will be in Penn Township, approximately 600 feet from the Centre Township line. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

A motion was made by Jason Troutman and seconded by James Fitterling to accept the withdrawal of the Long Annexation Minor Subdivision Plan as per the letter from C2C Design Group, dated January 19, 2022. Upon roll call, Troutman, Fitterling and Zimmerman voted yes.

The position of Emergency Management Coordinator was tabled.

The road crew requested trading overtime hours for comp time. There will need to be a provision added to the employee handbook.
