ORDINANCE No. 100-2002

AN ORDINANCE OF CENTRE TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE No. 2 OF APRIL, 1971, AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO (ORDINANCE No. 56 OF APRIL, 1986, AND ORDINANCE No. 81 OF DECEMBER 1998), WHICH ORDINANCES ESTABLISHED THE CENTRE TOWNSHIP/CENTERPORT BOROUGH JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION; WITHDRAWING FROM THE CENTRE TOWNSHIP/CENTERPORT JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION; CREATING THE CENTRE TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION; AND PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Centre Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by the authority of the same, pursuant to the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, as from time to time amended, and the Municipalities Planning Code, as from time to time amended, as follows:

SECTION 1. Repeal of Ordinance No. 2 of April 1971. Effective September 12, 2002, Ordinance No. 2 of April 1971 of Centre Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and all amendments thereto (including Ordinance No. 56 of April 1996 and Ordinance No. 81 of December 1998), which Ordinances created the Centre Township/Centerport Borough Joint Planning Commission, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. Withdrawal from the Joint Planning Commission. Centre Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania hereby withdraws from the Centre

Township/Centerport Borough Joint Planning Commission established by Ordinance No. 2 of April 1971, as from time to time amended.

SECTION 3. Creation of Centre Township Planning Commission.

Effective contemporaneously with the withdrawal of Centre Township from the Centre Township/Centerport Borough Joint Planning Commission as set forth in Section 4 hereof, and the repeal of Ordinance No. 2 of 1971, and all amendments thereto, there is hereby created the Centre Township Planning Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "Township Planning Commission").

SECTION 4. Membership, Powers, and Duties of the Township Planning Commission.

The Township Planning Commission, in accordance with Section 205 of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10205, shall be comprised of six (6) members, and shall have powers and duties as determined by the Centre Township Board of Supervisors, including but not limited the powers and duties set forth in Section 209.1(a) of the Municipalities Planning Code, 53 P.S. Section 10209.1(a).


SECTION 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, phrase, paragraph, clause, term, or provision hereof is determined to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction or by any state or federal agency or regulatory authority having jurisdiction thereof, such determination shall have no effect on the validity of any other section, sentence, phrase, paragraph, clause, term, or provision hereof, all of which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances. Except as otherwise provided herein, all existing ordinances or portions of ordinances are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.


SECTION 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective on September 12, 2002.
