## ORDINANCE NO. 136 -2=11

AN ORDINANCE OF CENTRE TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, MAKING A PORTION OF GRIMM AVENUE A ONE WAY ROAD

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Centre, Berks County, Pennsylvania, it is necessary and desirable to make a certain portion of road known as Grimm Avenue, at the point where Grimm Avenue meets Railroad Road heading west a distance of approximately fifty feet (50'), a one way road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Centre, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. A portion of a certain road known as Grimm Avenue, at the point where Grimm Road meets Railroad Road heading west a distance of approximately 50 feet (50'), will become a one way road, as more fully depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference thereto.

Section 2. No left turns shall be permitted from Railroad Road onto Grimm Avenue.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Centre that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective in accordance with the law.
