ORDINANCE NO. 147-2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CENTRE, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING SECTION 5.06, ENTITLED MOBILE/MANUFACTURED HOMES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, OF ARTICLE V, ENTITLED "TECHNICAL PROVISIONS", OF ORDINANCE NO. 143-2012, ADOPTING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS, BY PROHIBITING MOBILE/MANUFACTURED HOMES AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES WITHIN ANY SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREA

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Supervisors of the Township of Centre, Berks County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter "Township"), and it is hereby ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 21-1980 adopted on November 12, 1980, Ordinance No. 24-1984 adopted on November 14, 1984, Ordinance No. 33-1987 adopted on April 8, 1987, and Ordinance No. 76-1997-11 adopted on November 12, 1997, all pertaining to Floodplain Management Regulations, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Section 5.06, entitled "Mobile/Manufactured Homes and Recreational Vehicles", of Article V, entitled "Technical Provisions", of Ordinance No. 143-2012, adopting Floodplain Management Regulations, is hereby amended in its entirety so as to hereafter read as follows:

Section 5.06 Mobile/Manufactured Homes and Recreational Vehicles. Within any Special Flood Hazard Area, mobile/manufactured homes and recreational vehicles shall be prohibited.

Section 3. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days following the date of adoption.
