MINUTES DECEMBER 16, 2025

The regular meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on December 16, 2025 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road Mohrsville, PA. Chairman Jason Troutman called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. **APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:**

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT:**

**ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT:** James Fitterling reported that our Road Crew has been cleaning up the snow on Township roads, installing snow fences on some property and maintaining the equipment.

A motion was made by Jason and seconded by Melissa to release Escrow # 5 in the amount of \$6714. For Tiny Pear. Motion passed.

Shane reported on the continuing problem with the fibre-optic issue with the flaggers or lack thereof. A Stop Order was issued and an in-

person meeting took place at the Township office regarding the issues. After the issues were addressed to Ryan Rhode the Stop Order was rescinded.

The Fuel Pump update was tabled.

#### ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Mr. Fiant reported that there were 19 permits issued with the total construction value of \$573215.27. 22 building inspections performed and 10 certificates of occupancy issued. There is a property maintenance issue at 236 Shannaleigh Drive and citations were issued today.

#### NEW BUSINESS:


A motion was made by Melissa and seconded by Jason to approve the 2026 Budget. Motion passed.
