

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES
JANUARY 27,2026

The regular meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on January 27, 2026 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road Mohrsville, PA. Chairman James Fitterling called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: James Fitterling, Melissa Krishock Member, Daniel Unterkofler, Member, Solicitor Matthew Fessler, Ryan Rhode, Jeff Fiant, Constable Kevin Noecker, and Joe Kaczor resident.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

A motion was made by Melissa and seconded by Daniel to approve the minutes from December 16, 2025, and January 4, 2026. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Melissa and seconded by Daniel to pay bills from December 15, 2025 thru January 26, 2026. Motion passed.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: NONE

ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT: Daniel reported that our Road Crew has been cleaning up the snow after the snow storms on Township roads. Maintaining equipment and overall cleaning of down branches throughout the Township. The Road Crew was commended for consistent year-round quality work. The fuel pumps at the maintenance facility continue to be having problems despite the vehicles now able to pump fuel.

ENGINEER'S REPORT:

The Fuel Pump update. Ryan received quotes from Hafer Equipment to completely remove the fuel tanks from the property. Because it is over

the allowed bidding threshold other quotations need to be obtained. Ryan will proceed with obtaining other bids. Hafer also quoted a possibility of the Township doing most of the work in the removal of the fuel tanks. After discussion it was agreed by all to allow the complete project to be bid.

Ryan received quotes from both Nolt's and Countryside for the purchase of said tanks. Those quotes range from \$7040 To \$8422 for a new 1000. Gallon diesel tank. A discussion took place regarding the construction of a structure closure to cover the tanks while fueling. This will be on the agenda for further discussion.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Jeff Fiant of Kraft Municipal Services reported there were 6 permits issued totaling \$390,000 in construction value. 27 inspections were completed. The code issue for 236 Shannaleigh Way were issued but no hearing has been scheduled as of yet. The code issue at 402 Plum is resolved.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to authorize the release of Ray T Davis the unused escrow in the amount of \$953.50. Motion passed.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa for Resolution 2026-10 for the Penny Hill Sud-Division sewer module. Motion passed.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Daniel to authorize the escrow release #6 in the amount of \$30,000. for the Tiny Pear Apartment escrow. Motion passed.

SEO REPORT: JB Environmental Services:

A sewer permit and final inspection was performed at 678 Schuylkill Hill Rd.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to authorize a snow emergency declaration for Centre Township for Saturday January 24, 2026, and to cancel the emergency on Wednesday, January 28, 2026. Motion passed

Joe Kaczor, Planning Commission Chair informed the Board of Scott Wallace's resignation from the Commission due to his moving from the Township. Joe asked if the Board could please send a letter thanking him for his years on the Commission. They instructed Debbi to please send a letter. Joe, informed the Board he has a replacement for the position. The Board will place the name on the agenda for acceptance at the next meeting.

With there being no further discussion a motion was made by Melissa and seconded by James to adjourn the meeting at 7:40.
