

CENTRE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES
MARCH 24, 2026

The regular meeting of the Centre Township Board of Supervisors was held on March 24, 2026 at the Centre Township Municipal Building, 449 Bucks Hill Road Mohrsville, PA. Chairman James Fitterling called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a Moment of Silence. The following were present: James Fitterling, Melissa Krishock Member, Daniel Unterkofler, Member, Solicitor Liz Magovern, Shane Strausser, Jeff Fiant, and Constable Kevin Noecker.

APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES:

A motion was made by Melissa and seconded by Daniel to approve the minutes from February 24, 2026. Motion passed.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to pay bills thru March 24, 2026. Motion passed.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT: Executive session regarding possible litigation.

ROAD DEPARTMENT REPORT: The road department has been trimming trees through out the Township and also assisted with the trimming in Penn Township. The road crew will start crack sealing this week.

ENGINEER'S REPORT: No further update on the fuel pump removal at this time. Board may visit site to assess situation and determine phases and budget parameters.

A primary paving project is being considered for Grove Rd from Centerport to Railroad Roads at a cost of \$101,566.50 for leveling and overlay. A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to

move forward with contract document preparation and bidding process. Motion passed.

The Township received notification of an ACT 14 project in the Township. Penn Dot will be receiving permit applications for the project which is Railroad Rd over Irish Creek Bridge Maintenance Project. The secretary will respond with our response.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Jeff Fiant of Kraft Municipal Services reported there were 9 permits issued totaling \$181,987.00 in construction value. 9 inspections were completed. The code issue for 236 Shannaleigh Way is still pending. A property maintenance issue in the Fairview Mobil Home Park is slowly being cleaned up by the owner who had fire damage.

NEW BUSINESS:

The US Postage permit is due for renewal. It was decided not to renew at this time.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to approve the placing of signs on Schuylkill Hill Rd., Main St., and Railroad Rd. by the Sept 11th National Memorial Trail Alliance program. Motion passed.

A motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to allow the Patriotic Order Sons of America to place a small mail box to collect forms for the 250th Celebration. The purpose of this is to hopefully get every home in Centre Township and Centerport to put a flag in the front of their property. There will be 5 \$100. gift cards to entice participation.

A motion was made by Melissa and seconded by Daniel to send notification to Berkshire Hathaway regarding our non-participation in the sale of land for a Solar Tower. Motion passed.

A resident has contacted the office regarding the collapsing of a retaining wall in the right-of-way of 101 Railroad Rd. This issue was

brought in front of the BOS 2 years ago. The property has since been sold and the new owner is asking for an update. Current owner expects Township to replace this wall. This was sent back to the Engineers for more information.

The Township received a letter from the Berks County Planning Commission regarding a Preliminary/Final Plan for a tract that is both in Penn and Centre Township. A small portion of this land is in Centre Township and must receive copies of the plan to review. When plan is finalized Centre Township must sign the plans for recording. An executive session was held after the adjournment of the regular meeting. No action will be taken.

With there being no further discussion a motion was made by James and seconded by Melissa to adjourn the meeting at 7:27 P.M.
